- Fitness sampler classes
- Arts and crafts
- Gymnastics/tumbling
- Bouncy castles
- Virtual reality gaming courtesy of VRKAde
- Airhouse trick station courtesy of Airhouse Nanaimo

- Roaming entertainment

Food trucks will be on site in the Beban breezeway. These include Tacomania, Donairnutz and Alkhalid Food. In addition, West Coast Coffee will be selling food and refreshments in the pool lobby and in Frank Crane Arena.

Tickets are available on the day of the event or in advance at Beban Park Pool office. Tickets are only \$10 or purchase a "festive five" pack for \$35, and tickets would make great stocking stuffers.
