



## PROCLAMATION


### PROSTATE CANCER AWARENESS MONTH SEPTEMBER 2018

- WHEREAS: the survival rate for prostate cancer can be over 100% when detected early; and
- WHEREAS: those with a family history of the disease or those of African or Caribbean descent, are at a greater risk of developing prostate cancer; and
- WHEREAS: the City of Nanaimo supports Prostate Cancer Canada and all individuals committed to raising awareness about prostate cancer.
