

PROCLAMATION

ROTARY "END POLIO NOW" DAYS NOVEMBER 8 – 10, 2018

WHEREAS: This fall marks the 33rd anniversary of Rotary's PolioPlus program (the

first initiative to tackle global polio eradication through the mass vaccination of children), and the 30th anniversary of the Global Polio Eradication Initiative (a public-private partnership that includes Rotary, the World Health Organization, the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, UNICEF, the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, and

governments of the World); and

WHEREAS: Rotary in co-operation with its partners, sponsors and hundreds of

thousands of volunteers has reduced the number of polio cases by 99.9 percent and reached more than 2.5 billion children in 122 countries

with the vaccine; and

WHEREAS: Although there are fewer polio cases today than ever before, it is the

single-minded focus of Rotary (and its associates) to not stop working

until there is a total, worldwide eradication of this disease.

NOW THEREFORE I, Bill McKay, Mayor of the City of Nanaimo, do hereby proclaim November 8 – 10, 2018 shall be known as:
